DIRECTIONS



- From Metro NY & NJ (Buses and Cars):** NY State Thruway N (I-87) to Exit 16 (Harriman) to Rt. 17W (future I-86). Take Exit 130 to Rt. 208N approximately 7 miles to Washingtonville. At town center, make right on Rt. 94E. Left at next traffic light onto Brotherhood Plaza Drive. Go past Stop & Shop. Entrance to Brotherhood on left.
- From Northern NY (Cars Only):** I-87S to Exit 17, to I-84W to Exit 5A. Make left onto Rt. 747. At end of Rt. 747, make right on Rt. 207. Make first left on Toleman Rd. (Low Clearance Tunnel) Proceed 4 miles. Make left on Ahern Blvd. Turn right on Brotherhood Plaza Dr. Entrance to Brotherhood on right.
- From CT (Cars Only):** I-84W to Exit 5A. Follow directions above from 5A.
- From PA (Cars only):** I-84E to Exit 5A. Follow directions above from 5A.
- Buses and Trucks:** Call for directions to avoid Low Clearance Tunnel

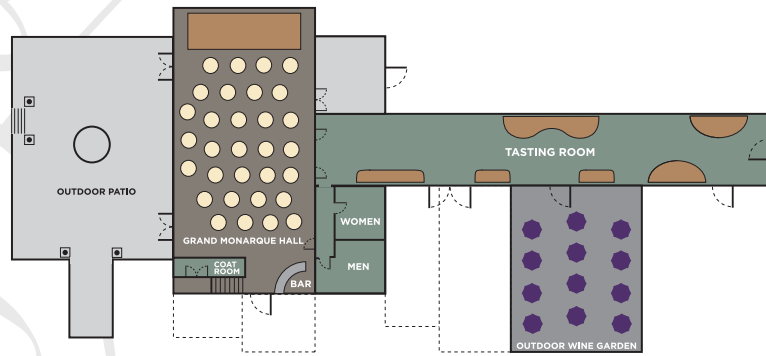


OLD WORLD CHARM AND ELEGANCE
